For the most part, these are community supplies, so please only label the two folders, two notebooks, binder and water bottle.

- 2 sturdy folders
- 2 notebooks
- Watercolors (Prang preferred brand)
- Pack of glue sticks and one bottle of glue
- 1 water bottle with student's name on it
- 1 backpack that can fit their take-home folder and lunch box
- 1 container of all-natural cleaning product
- 1 old small towel or rag for cleaning tables
- 1 box of markers (preferably Crayola) or colored pencils
- 1 box of crayons
- 1 box of Expo markers
- Rectangular erasers (the little pink ones for erasing pencil)
- 1 old clean sock (to use as an eraser for our white boards)
- Small 3-ring binder that is flexible (so they will fit in the book boxes)
- **For SPANISH: 1 unlined Journal (sketchbook) & one pocket folder**

1st Grade Supply List:

Thank you for your donations!

Please note, we combine all supplies with the exception of water bottles, notebooks and folders. Please do not label other supplies with your child's name. These items will be provided if your child is not able to bring them into class. If you have any questions or comments, please feel free to reach me at ebosque@creeksidesquaw.org. Each student needs:

- 1 water bottle with child's name to store at school during the week
- 1 **extra-sturdy** folder for homework and notes home (2 pockets)
- 4 two-pocket folders - labeled with student's name (1 for Spanish*, 1 for Math, 1 for Reading Groups, 1 for Misc.)
- 1 pair of child-safe scissors - labeled with student's name
- 1 package of sharpened pencils with erasers
- 1 box of crayons
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1-2 packages of small glue sticks (preferably white in color)
- 1 **12-inch** ruler - labeled with student's name
- 2 lined paper notebooks (100-200 page, wide rule, 8 x 10.5 inch) - labeled with student's name (1 for Spanish & 1 for Social Studies)
- 1 backpack (large enough to fit lunch box and folders) - labeled with student's name
- Large, used button-down shirt (adult sized) that will be for an **"art jacket"**

***For SPANISH:** 1 unlined 8x11 Journal (sketchbook) & one pocket folder - both labeled with student's name

Optional, but wonderful to have:

- Cozy cushion for student's individual use on chair or carpet (sized appropriately for your child and labeled with student's name)
- 1 box of colored markers
- 1 package of dry erase markers (any color)
- Ziploc bags – any size
- 1-2 containers of disinfecting wipes or all-natural cleaning product
- 1-2 boxes of tissues
- 1-2 rolls of paper towels
- Art & Crafts Supplies: popsicle sticks, wasabi tape (any color/design), white liquid glue, wooden clothes pins, finished paper towel rolls, pipe cleaners (any color), white or colored cardstock, glitter, stickers, etc...

Starting in 6th grade, we ask students to bring their own chromebook to school. If you would prefer to borrow one from the school for the year, please arrange through Mr. Jeff. Chromebooks will travel back and forth from home to school with the students.

All Subjects

EACH STUDENT should have the following:

- 2 large textbook covers (science, history)
- Pencils & erasers
- Blue & black pens
- Colored pencils and markers
- Glue sticks
- College ruled binder paper (you will need this daily in math/science)
- Index cards (blank or lined)
- Scissors
- ***Ruler*** (wooden or metal, not plastic as these tend to break easily)
- 2 packs of sticky notes (small and medium sized)
- Homework planner (If you don't have one, we can provide you with one)
- Highlighters (at least 3, all different colors)
- Durable, 3-hole punched pocket folder (to act as a "Homework Folder")

Math, Science, Art (for Ms. Grete)

- 8 Binder dividers
- Two 1 inch binders- one for math and one for science
- Colored correcting pens
- **Graph paper**
- 2 Sharpies- black, fine or medium point
- Dry erase markers (we use these daily)
- Calculator (NOT your phone), can be graphing or just regular

English & Social Studies (for Ms. Gretchen)

- **8th grade:** 2 composition notebooks (must be bound, NO SPIRAL), lined
- **7th grade:** 1 composition notebook (must be bound, NO SPIRAL), lined
