

Creekside Charter Covid-19 February 2021 Update

The intent of this document is to update our Board Approved Covid plan with relevant information and changes in policy.



On January 14th, CDPH guidance was released that slightly impacted our general operating procedures established Board approved in [August](#) and then updated in [December](#).

On February 1st, our Board approved our [CSP \(Covid Safety plan\)](#) checklist that states that we conform to all aspects of the CDPH new guidance with the exception of 4 feet of distance between desks. We will be submitting a safety review with CDPH in order to remain open without having to transition to a hybrid model.

With the exception of the 4 foot spacing mandate, Creekside charter was already compliant with all aspects of the new January 14th guidance including:

1. Stable grouping
2. Entrance and egress at the school
3. Health Screenings
4. Handwashing
5. Face coverings
6. Tracing of contacts
7. Staff testing
8. Family Education

We are very proud of the measures we have taken and will continue to follow all [CDPH guidance](#).

Loosening of restrictions:

The new CDPH guidance allows for symptomatic students to return after 24 hours with a negative test and no symptoms. We had been following the 72 hour rule. We have decided to allow students to return to campus after 48 hours assuming a negative test result
